Hello and welcome to the Classic Yacht Charitable trust,

The Classic Yacht Charitable Trust was formed in 2002 to preserve New Zealand's historic vessels and ensure they are not sold to other countries or left to deteriorate in tidal mudflats around New Zealand. When it became apparent that the historic keystone classic yacht the Waitangi, then based in Melbourne, could be sold and lost to not only New Zealand but the Southern Hemisphere, quick and decisive action by the trust secured the yacht for the Hauraki Gulf and the people of New Zealand's future enjoyment.

Since then the trust has secured the future of 7 vessels:

- **Waitangi** 58ft gaff cutter built in 1894 by Robert Logan Snr. Purchased from Australian syndicate who had completed a full restoration
- **Thelma** 60ft gaff cutter built in 1897 by Logan Brothers. Purchased in St Tropez returned to NZ and fully restored
- **Gloriana** 34ft gaff cutter built in 1892 by Logan Brothers. Salvaged from tidal mudflats and fully restored.
- **Frances** 44ft Gaff rigged cutter built in 1906 by Logan Brothers. Donated to the Trust by the Cato family
- **Te Hauraki** 40ft Auckland Harbour Board launch built by the harbour in 1920.
- **Kotiri** 40ft 1897 gaff cutter built by Logan brothers. Gifted by Donald Webster and currently in Donald's boatshed in Herne Bay awaiting restoration
- **Bandit** 24ft JOG Van De Stadt, built by Sir Peter Blake and his brother Tony in their parents back yard. Peter and Tony were aged 17 and 15 when Bandit was launched. Currently in storage awaiting restoration and placing on public display in Auckland
